GIANT INDIAN unhurried down the backstretch, picked up interest after completing the opening half, was taken gradually outward until in the four path midway around the turn, closed in and challenged for command as the field headed into the stretch, fought his way to a narrow advantage by the eighth pole, gamely edged away. TALK THERAPY off a beat slowly, rushed up under his own power to secure a forward position, pressed the issue three wide and from between rivals for a good portion of the way around the turn, displayed good determination down the stretch en route for the place. HANDSOME HARBOR strung out along the overland route at the three-eighths pole, proved no match. ASSURED VICTORY vied from the inside, was put to some light urging leaving the backstretch, remained prominently placed before flattening out in the last eighth. INDUCE disputed the pace from near the two path, came under heavy pressure approaching the quarter pole and soon succumbed to it.
