Footnotes

REGGIE D bobbed at the start, raced from off the inside, was asked for some run early down the backstretch, departed the backstretch two wide and having been put to what turned out to be a prolonged hard drive, nudged a complying STONE ROCKS out of the three path midway on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, steadily chopped away at the deficit, took over with a few jumps to spare before reaching the wire. KELTIC FIGHTER stacked five wide at the half mile pole, continued from well off the inside thereafter, although a bit closer to the rail, poked a head down in front spinning into the stretch three to four wide, offered good resistance before relinquishing in the final seventy yards. ICE WAGON vied for command while taking the inside route, fell back slightly halfway around the bend, got taken outward and proceeded to angle three wide into the stretch, staged a mild comeback to claim the show award. KISSED AND MISSED commenced the run around the bend being four wide, finished willingly to earn the final major slice of the pot. STONE ROCKS brushed after the start, raced three to four wide for most of the way around the turn, gave way. INDIGENE CHARM in the three path and under a drive by the three-eighths pole, made no headway. WOBURN disputed the pace from the two path, tired steadily after getting displaced coming to the top of the lane. PEGASUS TIGER four wide and between opponents at the half mile pole, folded. HOTCHOI reared up shortly before the field was off and running, getting its head stuck in the starting gate. After a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race, HOTCHOI was declared a non-starter judged not have to have gotten a fair beginning.
