FULL N SASSY cruised to the front leaving the starting gate, took up position in the two path soon afterwards, was well rated setting the splits, under the watchful eye of the runner up, continued along on the same scenario for six furlongs, responded positively when given her cue in upper stretch, maintaining a safe distance from SPRING ELUSION throughout the stretch to prove best. SPRING ELUSION three wide, was rating stalking the pacesetter until the quarter pole, was called upon prior to entering the stretch, continued on with good energy, but was out finished by the top one. RIVER FANCY underwent a four wide pursuit and proved no match for the top twosome. CHEROKEE TRICK raced along the outside, was urged on the turn but failed to respond. ROYAL VESSEL four wide at the half mile pole, folded. MESA GIRL took the inside route, was forced to vacate the premises to clear a tiring rival in upper stretch, lacked a kick. SISTER IN THE CITY faded off a ground-saving journey.
