WON GREAT CLASSIC reserved in the two path for nearly a half, ranged up to the leader when ready, leaving the five-sixteenths pole, took off in earnest when set down after entering the lane, collared the front runner to take over at the furlong marker, then dug in under a drive to preserve the decision. KHAN OF KHANS shot out of the gate to take command in a flash, tucked along the rail in time for the run around the bend, was asked for a response as the top one readied his challenge approaching the quarter pole, offered good resistance before yielding at the eighth pole, but dug in stubbornly to turn back a pair of late-closing foes and hold on for the place. LE BONNE VIE unhurried for a half, commenced to rally four wide at the head of the stretch and got out finished. ELTISH STAR three wide at the three-eighths pole, came home belatedly en route for the final major share. RED ELEPHANT saved ground and tired. HE'S A SCROOGE broke outward, chased the pacesetter from the outside for a half and folded.
