Footnotes

STRAY BULLET rode the pocket, well within range of a fighting foursome during the opening half, vacated the premises coming to the midway point on turn, remained on hold, bidding time for the rest of the way around the bend, swung from the two path into the stretch and was asked for run, altered course to be outside the front runners in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, gained readily, drew alongside the runner up with about a sixteenth remaining, grabbed the lead soon afterwards and edged away under good handling. PRIVATE COUNCEL departed the backstretch from the three path, moved up to issue a challenge from between rivals coming to the quarter pole, turned for home on nearly even terms with SONATA RIVER, out dueled that opponent to take over by the furlong marker, but with the eventual winner having made her presence at this juncture, held on gallantly until a short distance past the sixteenth pole. SONATA RIVER four wide, contested the pace, the widest member of an early four way scramble, struck the front arriving at the quarter pole, but under heavy pressure from the runner up, relinquished when unable to keep pace, and steadily tired. SHE TALKS TOO MUCH out hustled leaving the starting gate, was four wide departing the backstretch but down along the fence by the three-eighths pole, folded. LOUDER THAN SOUND along the rail, argued for control with three others for a good portion down the backstretch as well as part of the way on the turn, faltered after entering the stretch. DESERT SPEED disputed the pace from between foes and gave way. TAKEMETOTHERODEO disputed the pace between rivals from off the inside until the half mile pole, wilted and was got eased.
