Footnotes

CLASSIC R AND B came out of the gate alertly, quickly established control and settled along the inside, rated kindly on a loosely-contested lead, felt intensified pressure nearing the quarter pole and was let out in response, got pounced upon by GOODTIME BOY in upper stretch, waged war heads apart with that opponent until the wire, refused to yield en route to winning the head bob. GOODTIME BOY patiently stalked the winner from outside, ranged up to issue a challenge approaching the quarter pole and soon got turned loose, reached even terms by upper stretch, went head to head from there to the wire, got denied by an equally game opponent. FAST GRIEVANCE saved ground until the quarter pole, rallied well enough to secure the show, although never posing a threat to the gallant first two finishers. L. C. SLEEPY got off sluggishly, hitting the left side of the starting gate just after lunging at the break, darted into the two path in short order, then was placed along the inside before reaching the end of the homestretch, rode the rail throughout thereafter, cut the corner into the lane, hesitated momentarily after drawing up to ALVITO at the three-sixteenths pole, was put to both hand urging and given a barrage of right handed shots, lacked the needed response. ALVITO well placed from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, failed to fire when called upon. PERNICE three wide around both turns, was through after completing three-quarters. LIVING RIGHT slipped off the rail during the later stages of the run around the far turn, came up empty. PAWLEYS PORCH between rivals for a good portion of the opening six furlongs, swung four wide into the stretch, had no rally.
