ZETTERHOLM loped along on the rail for nearly three-quarters pole, slipped outward prior to the quarter pole, was placed four wide at the three-sixteenths pole and called upon for a response for the initial time, strode with good energy towards the runner up, collared that rival in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, quickly went by then edged away, completing the final seventy yards only mildly hand urged. SPORTSWRITER near the inside in the early stages, made a sudden move towards the middle of the track a short distance from the beginning of the backstretch, closed a narrow gap and took up position in the two path, parked just off the leader's hind quarters pole, moved when ready and took over the lead during the later stages of the run around the bend, unasked for speed and with the former pacesetter having been set down to a drive, entered the stretch with a clear advantage and was called upon himself, left the eighth pole with his biggest margin, yielded to the top one while drifting outward with about a sixteenth to go, yet held on well to secure second. COALITION tracked the leader from the rail until the five-sixteenths pole, was already under encouragement entering the stretch, got put to a strong whip but could make no headway on the front runners. QUIET FAVORITE three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, had no kick. CAT PAWS established control down the chute, eventually tucked along the rail, was put to a drive by midway on the turn once SPORTSWRITER drew alongside, succumbed nonetheless, then retreated.
