SWAGGER JACK gave chase from the outside, swung four wide into the stretch, got called upon and mustered up a strong kick that carried him to the lead with a furlong to go, dug in well thereafter to preserve the decision. SAHARA SKY moved quickly towards the inside and settled into the two path, was content to be well reserved for a half, began to pick up the pace gradually moving outward at the same time towards the top of the lane, altered course to be outside all front runners at the three-sixteenths pole, came home with good energy, but fell short. DISCREET DANCER unhurried for a half, crept up three wide from the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch and challenged in earnest, kept up the pursuit before flattening out late. FORT LOUDON lost his footing at the break, coming out slightly and making contact with the nearest opponent, stalked the pacesetter from the pocket, was grabbed hold of twice while put in a bit tight by CONSORTIUM, the first time a short distance past the half mile pole, and later on in upper stretch, bided time behind the front runners before altering course to the middle of the strip with about a sixteenth remaining, failed to make any significant headway. CONSORTIUM bumped lightly with FORT LOUDON at the start, kicked free of a tightly-packed bunch in the initial stages to grab the advantage, showed the way, kept at a slight distance from off the rail, facing honest pressure all the while, got let out for the stretch drive, yielded before completing the next furlong and backed away. BRIGAND pressed the issue towards the two path, turned for home between rivals and gave way.
