STAKES Wood Memorial S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$10,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$20,000 along with the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$5,000 rebate. Any horse that competes in both the Gotham and the Wood Memorial will have their subscription fees waived for the Wood Memorial. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2013 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Wood Memorial has been selected as one the races in the second leg of the Kentucky Derby Championship Series. The winner of the Wood Memorial will be awarded 100 points, the second place finisher 40 points, the third place finisher 20 points and the fourth place finisher 10 points. 123 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, March 23, 2013 with 71 Nominations.

Footnotes

VERRAZANO came out of the starting gate alertly with no apparent mishap, maintained a forward position, keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, two to three wide around the first turn and down the backstretch, was given his cue and accelerated by CHRISANDTHECAPPER soon after entering the far turn, was briefly clear but raced on nearly even terms with the previously mentioned foe for the rest of the way to the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for run, raced a bit erratically leaving the furlong marker, dug in stubbornly to prove best. NORMANDY INVASION caught in tight a few strides after the start, was bumped and gently pinched back, recovered in short order and took up position along the outside in midpack, kept within striking distance heading for the far turn, continued to bide time as about a handful of members momentarily congregated at the three-eighths, went on a little farther then angled outward after being given his cue, commenced the stretch drive from the four path,

showed good late foot to procure the place. VYJACK unhurried along the outside for nearly three-quarters, angled three wide into the stretch, finished willingly but had to settle for the show. MR PALMER raced along the outside, was put to some encouragement after completing three-quarters, altered course coming to midstretch and rallied to secure the last major check. ELNAAWI came inward leaving the gate, was pulled off the nearest rival but not before making some contact with one of them and causing some crowding, that affected two others, contently tracked the front runners from the outside, entered the stretch still within range and was set down, flattened out. CHRISANDTHECAPPER managed to avoid the crowding incident a short distance out of the starting gate, offered some resistance to the rating tactics being applied by the rider by fighting against the bit proceeding down the homestretch, went about more professionally after reaching the opening bend, cut the pace on an open lead, got confronted by the winner departing the backstretch, proved powerless to stall that one's bid and yielded, remained prominently placed hugging the rail to midlane before backing away. QUINZIEME MONARQUE was lightly bumped after the start, loped along in the initial stages, kept near the two path, was under a drive getting placed six wide at the top of the lane, made no impact. GO GET THE BASIL three wide on the opening turn, raced at a considerable distance from off the rail throughout, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, gave way. ALWAYS IN A TIZ hung out four wide on both turns, was outrun. FREEDOM CHILD had just been loaded into his stall when the field was sent on its way and as a result got off in a tangle while still being in the assistant starter's hands, raced three wide for most of the way on the opening bend, rank under restraint by the rider, tipped outward five wide early down the backstretch and advanced steadily towards the front runners departed the half mile pole from the four path and maintained the momentum to reach a contending position halfway on the far turn, had little left by upper stretch and gave way. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race, FREEDOM CHILD was declared a non starter for wagering purposes, having been deemed not given a chance for a fair start.
