WE'LL TALK broke a couple of steps outward at the start, assumed a forward position, prompted the runner up, starting from the two path, had that opponent gradually but steadily drift out during the run around the bend, was thus four wide challenging earnestly for command as the field turned for home, took over shortly afterward and stayed comfortably in the clear, kept busy to the end. MIDNIGHTINPOSITANO came away with no apparent mishap, reached the half mile pole at a slight distance from off the rail, gradually drifted out during the next quarter, was in the three path heading home, got overhauled but held on reasonably enough to salvage second. TAYLOR JAGGER sat reserved in midpack during the initial stages, was let out and launched a three wide run from midpoint on the turn, issued an abbreviate bid a furlong later, lacked a winning bid. ROCK SHOW brought up the back of the pack, tucked along the rail coming to the five-sixteenths marker, stayed along it until midstretch, flattened out. WILDICHI placed along the inside route after more than halfway around the bend, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
