NOW MORE THAN EVER raced close up along the inside, found room on the rail in the stretch and dug in to get the place spot. SALT AND PEPPER raced close up while between rivals and finished well outside. ODETTA ONE was outrun early and was going well too late. SONG OF SARAH raced wide and had no response when roused. EDY M quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. GETOUTOFMYFACE raced inside and had no rally. LITTLE CAMMIE tired after showing brief speed. ZIP CITY DANCER chased the pace while three wide and tired.
