### Footnotes

SILVER WAGON was outrun early, raced three wide, responded when roused, finished strongly outside and drew clear late under a drive. DIABOLICAL raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch, ran with the winner into deep stretch then dug in to hold the place. AH DAY was outrun along the inside early, angled out in upper stretch and was going well late outside. LATENT HEAT contested the pace while between rivals, drew clear in upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. KEYED ENTRY contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. KAZOO was hustled up inside, contested the pace for a half mile and tired.
