STAR OF NEW YORK pressed three wide, made a bid on the turn, got the lead and edged clear late. RISES THE PHOENIX raced well back for six furlongs and closed late from outside to gain the place. GOOD LAW dueled between horses into midstretch and weakened. STOPBLUFFING failed to mount a serious rally. BILLY BEAR dueled on the rail into upper stretch and tired. SUCCESS FEE was never a factor. SOUTH FOURTH ST. faded after leaving the turn.
