### Footnotes

FRAZIL away well, pressed the pacesetter from the outside, with the rider sitting aboard with a good grip on the reins, moved when ready from midpoint on the turn, went by a more energetically-handled THE ZIPSTER to take over a sixteenth down the road, turned for home holding a clear advantage, lengthened away during the run through the furlong grounds, having now been called upon for run, then increased the winning margin during the last eighth being kept busy to the end. SURE SUCCESS between rivals for most of the way around the turn, displayed enough stretch energy to be along for the place. SHERAGUSKA outrun for a half, swung three wide into the stretch and outkicked weak ones to grab the show. THE ZIPSTER was placed near the rail coming to the half mile pole, got readily displaced by the top one in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole despite receiving heavy encouragement and steadily tired thereafter. MISSILE MOTOR tracked the front runners taking the inside route and tired. VIABLE chased three wide, was urged on the turn and folded.
