Footnotes

AMPERSAND reserved in midpack from between rivals for much of the run around the far turn, was asked for run angling three wide into the stretch, entered the lane full of run and with full clearance dead ahead, gained rapidly on the leader, overhauled that rival leaving the eighth pole and drew off under good handling. MIA POPPY rated inside until the quarter pole, had no answer when the winner arrived on the scene, continued onward to be second best. KNOCK QUIETLY away well, secured the pocket shortly after departing the elbow chute, contently tracked the pacesetter from there under a good hold by the rider, narrowed the gap late on the second turn then got called upon, proved no match for the top twosome, but won a protracted duel with MIKE AND ROB for show honors. MIKE AND ROB unhurried for off the inside down the backstretch, made a dash into the four path coming to the three-eighths pole, failed to cut into the leader's margin after entering the stretch nor catch KNOCK QUIETLY for third. PAPA TOM saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. SNACKS inside in the initial stages, travelled two wide on the far turn, was forced to await suitable options approaching the quarter pole, had sufficient rallying room by upper stretch, but lacked the necessary response. SELJUK forwardly placed three wide for nearly six furlongs, tired. DREAMALOT saved ground throughout. IRISH ETIQUETTE took the overland route around the far turn, was through after completing three-quarters.

LIMANI swung three wide into the backstretch and was always outrun. TWO RICHARDS accompanied the pacesetter from the two path for six furlongs, then retreated. JOHNNY BEAUTIFUL failed to menace..
