BROADWAY'S ALIBI away without apparent mishap established control well before departing the chute, carved the pace, placed under a firm hold by the rider, with head tilted slightly to the left and facing only mild resistance, proceeding towards the half mile pole, went unchallenged throughout the run around the turn as well, had the closest pursuers get asked leaving the five-sixteenths pole as she turned for home holding a comfortable lead, went on a little farther then got asked for run herself, turned back the potential threat and scampered off once more, drifted outward down the lane, was repeatedly flashed the whip right handed by the rider to counteract it, completed the race leading by a clear margin and near the middle of the strip. WELCOME GUEST reserved early, advanced into contention from the three path around the turn, got called upon a few strides after SINGLET did, continued onward with good energy to garner the place, although never posing a real danger to the winner. MILLIONREASONSWHY rode the rail, cut the corner after having been under a drive from the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match. SINGLET sat parked in the two path just off the leader's hind quarters until the five-sixteenths pole, was set down at that station, but lacked the needed response. NUFFSAID NUFFSAID took the inside route, was coaxed along early, failed to reach contention. BOURBONSTREETGIRL broke outward slightly, raced along the outside, came three wide into the stretch, had no offering.
