### Footnotes

TRINNIBERG grabbed command shortly after the start, rated kindly setting the opening split well out in the middle of the track down the backstretch, was gradually guided closer to the rail and took up residence in the two path by the half mile pole, continued to show the way from there on a clear advantage and unasked for speed, turned for home and shook free from more energetically-handled rivals, himself only placed to the mildest of hand rides, was given two shots of the whip right handed to maintain a straight course just past the sixteenth pole, crossed the wire under a mild hand ride. HARDENED WILDCAT shied away from an errant opponent at the start, settled near the back of the pack from off the inside during the initial stages, departed the backstretch three wide, improved position slightly from the half mile pole to end of the bend, spun into the lane and was set down, drifted towards the two path in midstretch after being on the receiving end of strong right handed stick work, came home with good energy but had to settle for being second best. HOW DO I WIN underwent a three wide pursuit and proved no match for the first two finishers. MAAN came in sharply at the start, raced in midpack from off the inside, was forced to alter course to the outside once his lane got shut down by two others in midstretch, got up late for the final major award. KING AND CRUSADER tracked from the inside and faltered. PHIL DANCER got off slowly, brought up the rear of the field for nearly a half, swung three wide into the stretch under encouragement, made no headway on the front runners. PERFECT TRIPPI guided to the rail at the seven-sixteenths pole, faded. COPY MY SWAGGER sat reserved while taking the inside route, flip flopped spots with PERFECT TRIPPI leaving the backstretch, taking over the two path just vacated by that rival in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, got called upon a furlong down the road, but had little left to offer.
