QUIET POWER patiently stalked the pacesetter during the initial stages from the two path, advanced steadily towards that rival upon entering the turn, drew abreast after more than halfway around it and quickly went by to take over, entered the stretch and got called upon, staved off ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY during the ensuing furlong, drifted out late but remained well clear at the wire. ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY underwent a three wide pursuit, was under solid encouragement by the five-sixteenths marker, took aim on the winner after turning for home, failed to dent that's margin and had to settle for the place. EQUIVOCATION saved ground before slipping into the two path heading for home, lacked the needed response. BURNED BRIDGES chased four wide on the turn and tired. BUDGE MAN placed in the five path at the head of the stretch, offered no serious bids. SPRINGCOURT along the inside early, swung four wide into the lane to no avail. SHANKOPOTAMUS quickly established control, showed the way being rated along the inside, extended the lead between calls down the backstretch, felt a quartet of foes closing in during the early stages of the run around the bend, was let out in response to it, yielded readily and faltered.
