Footnotes

CHLOE BEAR settled into the middle of the field from off the inside, bided time for nearly three-quarters, was cued up and unleashed a four wide ru from the five-sixteenths pole, nearly at the same time the runner up was unveiling his own move, only down along the rail, entered the turn full of momentum, gained ground readily on CELESTA making her way through the furlong grounds, took over with about seventy yards to go and edged away. CELESTA was unhurried from the outside until nearing the end of the backstretch, tucked along the inside at that juncture, waited until coming to the five-sixteenths marker and after being released from a firm took off after the front runners with a good burst of speed, cut the corner, well within striking distance, slipped by the former pacesetter, that rival having drifted into the two path in upper stretch, and grabbed away the lead, arrived at the eighth pole with the eventual winner in hot pursuit, held on well before relinquishing in deep stretch. LIFE'S A STAGE was guided over to the inside very soon after the start, rode the rail for most of the way around the first turn before swinging into the two path entering the backstretch, picked up the pace approaching the end of the far turn, entered the stretch five wide, got tipped a bit wider shortly afterwards, closed in with good energy en route for the show. SHEEDBDAWON contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside until the head of the stretch, got asked for run but lacked the needed response. FANTASTIC EYES departed the opening bend three wide, remained well off the rail thereafter, launched a five wide run coming to the five-sixteenths pole that carried her into a strong contending position for the commencement of the stretch, flattened out. BUNHEAD off alertly, grabbed the early advantage and was sent over to the rail, cut the pace, rated along on a loosely-contested lead and did so for slightly over three-quarters, turned for home under heavy pressure and got let out, drifted into the two

path during the initial portion of the stretch run, leaving the rail exposed, had the second place finisher slip by from the inside and soon take over, tired steadily during the last eighth. CHRISSY GIRL forwardly placed three wide on both turns, gave way. GENTEELA saved ground and was no factor. JEALOUS stalked the leader from the outside for almost six furlongs before giving way. KAY SPITFIRE SANDY was never involved. GOLDARA placed three wide at the head of the stretch, was empty.
