### Footnotes

TORMENT two to three wide within range of the front, got asked swinging four wide in upper stretch, rallied with good energy to overhaul the leader just past the eighth pole under a drive going away at the end. SPECIAL SELECTION broke in at the start bumping with DOUBLE CLAP, was forwardly placed inside, shifted out a path down the backside just off the early leader, inherited the front from that foe four and half furlongs out, came under pressure vying with WINTER NOW through the turn, got set down at the top of the lane, dug in keeping on to the furlong grounds, was overhauled just past that station, got

leg weary late on while able to hold for the place. GRIFFIN ROCK saved ground in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, kicked on unable to make any headway on the front to the wire while along for the show. WINTER NOW just off the pace initially, vied two to three wide from the three eighths pole through the turn urged from the five-sixteenths, spun three wide in upper stretch and steadily weakened in the drive. TYCOON CAT towards the rear four wide early on, shifted to the two path at the three-eighths pole, came under urging at the five-sixteenths cornered for home around a tiring foe, rallied belatedly inside unable to make an impact. LIGHT OF MERCY three to four wide towards the rear, came under a ride swinging four wide in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. JACKIN MY STYLE steadied early on in tight leaving the chute, settled four deep in mid pack, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths and offered no response. SHOUTOUT two to three wide in mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, offered little before weakening in the stretch then was vanned off after the finish. DOUBLE CLAP bumped at the start when SPECIAL SELECTION broke inwards, settled towards the rear just off the inside and offered little. SKYVIEW PARK steadied early in tight leaving the chute, saved ground in mid pack pushed along from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and made no impact. PROUD DAY INDEED loose behind the gate contained in the chute momentarily prior to the start, ranged up to assume command early on under light coaxing, yielded the lead four and a half furlongs out, retreated through the field along the inside then was eased at the head of the stretch.
