### Footnotes

FULL LIQUIDITY was steadied slightly at the start to avoid breaking inward, swiftly advanced into contention down the chute under his own courage, maintained a good striking position during the run around the turn while receiving moderate encouragement, was placed to a hard drive approaching the head of the stretch, raced as a team with FORTUNATE RUN as that pair narrowed in and eventually displaced the pacesetter nearing the eighth pole, battled heads apart before securing the advantage with about a sixteenth to go, then dug in stubbornly under strong handling to preserve the victory. FORTUNATE RUN patiently stalked the leader while racing three wide, commenced his rally after reaching the quarter pole, rallied in tandem with the top one, poked a head in front during the run through the furlong grounds, yielded the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then mustered up enough to hold off a late-closing rival to preserve the place. FRAMED unhurried during the initial three-quarters, displayed a good late kick along the outside during the stretch drive. SEQUOYA MOUNTAIN set the pace from the two path until upper stretch before faltering. GIMMEANOTHERWINK well rated tracking the leader from the inside, tired after completing six furlongs.
