### Footnotes

GREEN ARROWS stalked the leader while racing along the outside, needed only hand encouragement to wrest command in upper stretch, lengthened out to a clear advantage with an eighth to go and maintained a safe winning margin while being kept busy to the finish line. WAYLADY raced three wide, was unable to reel in the top one during the stretch run but continued on well to secure second. DUGOUT DEPUTY a non-factor during the initial stages, ranged toward the front runners after reaching the turn, cut the corner turning for home, then sustaining her momentum, finished with good courage under a drive to be along for the show. INSINCERELY within range off the inside, displayed a mild rally after entering the lane. GATA PERRA stumbled at the start, circled past rivals from the outside under her own courage to reach contention by the quarter pole, failed to sustain the move leaving the furlong marker. CLASSY JET rated on the lead for a half, gave way. GLANCE MY WAY was never in contention. ROUSING KITTY saved ground to no avail. JEN'S DREAM well placed early, was put to encouragement on the turn to keep pace, but backed off.
