The Wood Memorial from Aqueduct (4:45 p.m. ET post) is the second leg and the Illinois Derby from Hawthorne (5:17 p.m. ET post) is the third and final leg. FOREST DANGER was outrun early, advanced steadied while three wide, responded when roused turning for home, dug in determinedly outside and was clear under the wire. MEDALLIST raced close up inside, angled out into the turn, chased the pace and dug in gamely to the wire. DON SIX quickly opened a clear lead, set a strong pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. UNFORGETTABLE MAX was outrun early, came wide entering the stretch and lacked a rally. MASS MEDIA was hustled along inside, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. PRIMARY SUSPECT was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused.
