IDEALHOUSE was kept in reserve between rivals in this tightly-packed group, found room to begin to maneuver when TIZ HIDDEN made a bid for the lead approaching the head of the stretch, eventually settled into the five path at the top of the stretch, commenced a rally once given her cue, grabbed the lead nearing the furlong marker, then held off the late-closing runner up under a drive. BAHAMA BOUND sat in the pocket, was forced to bide her time behind rivals until nearing the quarter pole, angled to the middle of the track in upper stretch, came home with good energy, but had to settle for being clearly second best. TIZ HIDDEN rated three wide during the initial stages, swung into action with a four wide bid after entering the turn only to flatten out. WHITE CHIFFON showed the way towards the inside with a pair of rivals in patient pursuit, gave way after going three-quarters. MYWIFENOSEVRYTHING prompted the pacesetter from between rivals until midstretch and gave way. MARKET COLLAPSE chased three wide and folded.
