Footnotes

CALLMETONY left the gate in good order and settled into a forward position, sat well placed in the two path, keeping pace with the front runners under light coaxing, angled out a bit wider into the lane and was soon fully roused, gained ground readily on the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, drew abreast of that opponent nearing the sixteenth pole, wrestling away the lead just prior to the finish line to prove best. LEAP DAY hustled early, took a brief respite before resuming the quest for the front leaving the half mile pole, vied for command while racing along the inside, shook off a pesky pair before reaching the quarter pole, was fully roused after entering the stretch, dug in with good determination as the top one edged closer departing the eighth pole, yielding reluctantly just before the wire. COGNITO off the inside, was put to a prolonged hard drive and rallied to grab the show. DIGGER KARAKORUM vied for the lead from the two path for a half and gave way. KILN CREEK swung five wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. FOUR STAR GENERAL bobbled at the start and was no factor. LOOKIN AT HER out broke the field, but was allowed to ease back into midpack, raced three wide

around the turn and tired after completing a half. RUN TO GRAND AVE. failed to menace. JALA FEVER pressed wide and folded. TEMORE raced along the outside and was through a half. GLOBAL EFFECT was guided quickly over to the rail, cut the corner into upper stretch under a drive but had no serious stretch offering. CODY GROVE trailed.
