Footnotes

TOBY'S CORNER away in good order, was quickly guided over to the inside, sat there with the rider applying a firm grip on the reins, taking the inside route, was forced to remain on hold, buried behind and amongst rivals on the far turn, moved up a bit leaving the five-sixteenths pole, but forced to pause once again as the field approached the quarter pole, availed of the opportunity to angle out sharply in upper stretch for racing clearance, commenced to rally willingly once called upon, altered course outward just past the three-sixteenths pole for optimal racing clearance, kicked in with good energy once the maneuver was completed, forged on ahead, cutting the gap with every stride, split rivals while assuming command at the sixteenth pole then dug in gamely to prevail. ARTHUR'S TALE sat reserved in midpack under a good hold between rivals, was forced to be kept on hold, getting mildly shuffled from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, found room to wiggle into three path, drafted behind NORMAN ABSJORNSON turning for home, tipped out an additional path after settling into upper stretch, responded positively when given his cue, gained readily on the leader, collared UNCLE MO in tandem with the winner in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, the first of the two to strike the front, battled hard and gamely to the end on his way to garnering place honors. UNCLE MO came out running and quickly established control, showed the way, well rated in the two path, around the first turn and down the backstretch, was gradually taken over to the rail in time for the second turn, came under some pressure for the initial time leading the field into the stretch, shook free momentarily during the ensuing furlong, was put to the test once more soon afterwards, succumbed to it with a sixteenth remaining but had enough left for the show, NORMAN ASBJORNSON unhurried for the opening three-quarters, swung three wide into the stretch, kicked in with good energy, closing in during the run through the furlong grounds, but could not sustain the bid. ISN'T HE PERFECT forwardly placed while well off the inside, left the backstretch four wide, bided time until midway on the second turn, ranged up, to issue his challenge for the lead upon hitting the quarter pole, kept up the pressure on UNCLE MO until midstretch before backing away. STARSHIP CAESAR coaxed tracking the leader from the pocket, came up empty for the stretch drive. SON OF POSSE underwent a three to four wide journey and failed to reach a contending position. PREACHINTOTHEDEVIL took the overland route on the far turn and folded. DUCA attended the pace three wide for three-quarters and gave way.
