### Footnotes

GLICKMAN brushed lightly with SWINGING TUNE leaving the starting gate, left the backstretch three wide but tucked into the two path after circling by FRENCH FURY, vied for the lead, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, turned for the home, still glued directly alongside SWINGING TUNE, kept pace with that much more energetically-handled opponent, under confident handling, spurted clear when put to hand encouragement nearing the eighth pole, opened up a clear advantage during the ensuing sixteenth, then was taken back well in hand to complete the race, MOON ON FIRE slow to settle, was asked early to pick up the pace down the backstretch, chose the three path for the run around the bend, burst upon the scene with a sudden display of speed approaching the five-sixteenths pole, swung widest of the front runners into the stretch and came home willingly to procure the place. MAKE RESERVATIONS placed under a firm hold by the rider leaving the gate, improved position along the rail, sat within range while taking the inside route around the bend, turned for home with a clear alleyway for the taking, got called upon, maintained a good striking position until midstretch before flattening out a bit. SWINGING TUNE was pulled off of GLICKMAN after brushing with that foe at the start, readily advanced to the front, vied for the lead with the top one, was set down entering the stretch, remained a prominent factor until the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter. PERCUSSION came out on the turn and failed to reach a contending position. FRENCH FURY off the inside, was through after completing a half.
