J J'S LUCKY TRAIN sat reserved in the two path, between rivals for much of the running during the initial stages, was asked for run, beginning a steady march to the outside leaving the five-sixteenths pole, settled into the five path after entering the stretch, rallied in earnest, made steady progress during the early portion of the stretch drive, picked up ground more readily departing the furlong grounds, rapidly cut into the leader's margin with long, powerful strides, collaring that rival a couple of jumps before reaching the wire to prove best. VENGEFUL WILDCAT was eased back into the role of stalker after being outsprinted by SMOKE IT RIGHT for the lead, contently prompted that opponent from the outside for nearly a half, moved up when ready to issue a challenge for the lead approaching midpoint on the turn, needed only a few jumps past that station to take over, led the field into the stretch with a clear advantage but several rivals in hot pursuit, emerged from the furlong grounds still in front, but still being pressured, felt the top one's presence by the sixteenth pole, yielded reluctantly just prior to the wire, but gamely held the place. JUSTIN PHILLIP tracked the leader from the inside under a firm hold, appeared eager departing the backstretch while boxed in tight among rivals, had the brakes applied with a tight grip on the reins a short distance from the seven-sixteenths pole, settled more kindly into the flow of things once released, found room to slip off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and sat, still kept on hold awaiting options, turned for home with an open two path directly up ahead, got called upon and made a nice run from upper stretch to the eighth pole but could not sustain the bid. BUFFUM appeared unsettled buried down on the rail amongst rivals during the opening stages, jostled a bit with a couple of the nearest foes at the half mile, still uncomfortable, acted more professionally when dragged back to last by the pilot and no longer surrounded, angled outward, assuming the path just vacated by the top one in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, spun four wide into upper stretch then went on rally mildly to secure the last major award. ROYAL CURRIER broke through the gate after leaping up, was given a long examination by the track veterinarian before being reloaded, proceeded to come out in good order, took up chase three wide around the turn, but could not sustain the bid after turning for home.

HARLAN'S HELLO three wide, was asked for a response at the three-eighths pole, but failed to gain ground appreciably. SMOKE IT RIGHT lightly urged to establish command, was set to a snug hold once clear of the field, showed the way along the inside for a half and gave way,.
