Footnotes

MORNING LINE underwent a three pursuit, was asked for a response spinning into the stretch, crept up towards the front runners during the ensuing furlong, collared the runner up at the sixteenth pole and edged away, hand urged to the wire. APRIORITY away well, moved up to assume the role of stalker down the backstretch, was placed in the two path and coaxed along, while keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, drew on even terms in upper stretch before being set down, forged to the front, but with the top one bearing down hard, just to his outside, attempted to stave off that one off, proved unable but held well enough to procure the place. YAWANNA TWIST worked out a tuck along the inside coming to the half mile pole, responded willingly when called upon to take the show. KENSEI flip flopped spots with YAWANNA TWIST at the half mile pole, stayed within range and then displayed a mild kick en route for the last major share. LAYSH LAYSH LAYSH lost ground as the tempo quickened around the turn, improved position belatedly, while never posing a serious threat. SUNRISE SMARTY angled sharply after leaving the gate to take up residence along the rail, cut the pace facing some resistance from the closest pursuers all the while, was let out at the five-sixteenths pole trying to maintain the lead, succumbed a quarter of a mile later and steadily tired thereafter. FASTUS CACTUS broke outward, but was still on top briefly, fell back towards the rear of the pack soon afterwards, swung five wide into the stretch but failed to muster up the needed response. MORE THAN A REASON saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and was never a menace.
