PETE'S FLEET broke in the air as the field was sent on its way, making solid contact with the left side of the starting gate, was immediately given some motivation with the stick in the area of the right shoulder, responded positively to it and settled into midpack before reaching the end of the backstretch, raced three wide on the bend, kept to some light hand urging, bided time then got swung six wide into upper stretch, got switched over to a strong hand drive after having the pilot lose the whip a few jumps later, kicked into his best stride by the end of the furlong grounds, drew even with about a sixteenth to go, grabbed away the advantage and edged away. BOURBON THERAPY was patiently handling tracking the front runners from along the inside, was given his cue launching a bid as the half was being completed, with PACEMAKESTHERACE having drifted into the two path at this juncture, fought his way to a slim advantage during the next furlong, but with the eventual winner bearing down hard, offered good resistance before relinquishing in the late stages. PACEMAKESTHERACE rated near the inside, came under a heavy attack approaching the end of the bend, drifted towards the two path heading for the top of the lane, fought well but fell back by a sliver with a furlong remaining, weakened belatedly into the show slot. KING KONGRATS quickly tucked along the inside, launched a rail rally cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to muster up the needed response. TRISHA'S TROVE chased the leader from the three path, arrived at the five-sixteenths marker heavily roused, tired. FORGED prompted the pace from the two path to the quarter pole before giving way.
