Footnotes

SEEKER established control shortly after the start, set the pace, rated and from near the inside, picked up speed instantly when asked for a response a couple of jumps into the stretch drive, drifted out in the late stages, with the rider countering this action by flashing the stick from the right side, remained safely in the clear. I WANT YOU TO KNOW prompted the winner towards the two path, dug in well to preserve the place. CHASING MOONLIGHT was sent over to the rail departing the half mile pole, loomed briefly as a threat cutting the corner into the stretch, got outfinished. BUCKEYE HEART underwent a three wide pursuit on the bend, came slightly wider into the stretch, lacked the needed late response. STRAIGHT FAX forwardly placed early while racing at or near the inside, fell back noticeably as the tempo quickened approaching the end of the backstretch, was put to encouragement but failed to regain the lost ground, turned for home three wide and under a full drive, made no headway once again.
