FOREST DANGER quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside while in hand, responded when roused in upper stretch, drew away and widened under a drive. ABBONDANZA raced close up inside while in hand, dug in gamely when roused but could not get to the winner while clearly best of the others. INDIAN WAR DANCE pressed the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. SMOKUME was outrun along the inside early, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and had no rally. AMERICAN COMEDY chased the pace while between rivals and was finished early. JUDITHS WILD RUSH raced close up early and had no response when roused. LAST MINUTE DETAIL hit the gate at the start, dropped back early and had no rally. ROCKHEWN chased the pace while three wide and tired after a half mile.
