NATURAL SPEED reserved in midpack, picked it up a bit as the field headed for the stretch, swung three wide before commencing his rally, unleashed a good burst of speed, put a head in front just prior to the eighth pole, then drew off with authority under light encouragement. SUNY'S BOY contested the pace from the outside, rallied in earnest after being roused in upper stretch, disposed of the weakening leader, was unable to stave off the top one when that rival arrived at the scene by midstretch, but finished with determination to win the battle for second. GOLDEN MAN raced three wide and was outfinished for the place after a long stretch battle with the runner up. MATTHEW T C well-placed for a half, lacked a solid stretch bid. OVEREXTENDED was no factor. API MOHKAT failed to reach a contending position. GOLD SHAMROCK saved ground to no avail. RARE CUT cut the pace from the rail until upper lane and faded. STERLING HEAT was outrun.
