UPPER AFLEET off to an alert beginning, cut the pace from the inside, well rated and loosely-contested, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, drew well clear of the competition during the ensuing furlong and remained so. MACH TWELVE three wide around the far turn, rallied to be second best. MIGHTYLOVER reserved for nearly six furlongs, was set down in upper stretch and came home with a mild kick to take the show. WRIGHT RENDEZVOUS gave chase from the outside, failed to keep pace with the winner, despite being called upon at the five-sixteenths pole and steadily tired thereafter. PERFECT VELOCITY saved ground until the quarter pole, angled outward but lacked the needed closing punch. COMPLETELY BEAR three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, folded. CHASIN THE CASH saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. CRESCENT MOON DR trailed throughout.
