**Footnotes**

DISCO CAPOTE patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path, bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, drove to a clear advantage during the ensuing furlong and held sway, driving. FIVESTAR KARAKORUM tucked towards the inside at the half mile pole, rode the rail briefly, vacating the premises in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the lane and kicked in willingly to procure the place. JUDY'S WARRIOR was gradually swung outward after departing the backstretch, was strung out four wide by midpoint on the turn, entered the stretch under encouragement and finished with good energy en route for the show. DOUBLESPEAK was steadied at the start, brought up the rear of the pack for nearly a half, raced three wide for most of the way around the turn, was set down after settling into upper stretch and closed with good belated energy to grab the final major share. ALLEN'S AFFAIR was bumped after the start, raced along outside and went on to improve position down the stretch. AEGEAN STORM shied away from pressure coming from SULLY'S LANDING leaving the starting gate, making contact with ALLEN'S AFFAIR as a result, left the backstretch three wide, remained a forward factor until the eighth pole before weakening. SPENCERIFIC was steadied after becoming rank a few strides out of the gate, raced sluggishly for a brief period of time before settling back into proper stride, took the inside route around the bend, cut the corner under encouragement but lacked the necessary stretch response. SULLY'S LANDING was urged on the turn and tired. KINCSEM NOI accelerated to the front along the rail, showed the way from the inside, met resistance coming to the quarter pole, succumbed to it and faded.
