**Footnotes**

QUEEN OF PROTOCOL sat within striking distance taking the inside route, was let out turning for home, launched a rail rally, took over just past the eighth pole, then dug in with good determination to preserve it. MY LUCKEY PENNEY reserved in the two path for nearly three-quarters, responded positively when given her cue entering the stretch, displaying a good kick down the course to garner the place. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER set the pace along the inside on a loosely-contested lead, was asked for run when the pressure intensified approaching the quarter pole, relinquished the advantage leaving the furlong grounds but continued on with good courage to earn the show. RISKY GAMBLE within range off the inside, got out finished. SPECIAL JAK four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, improved position. JUDICIAL LEADER strung out three wide around the opening bend, attended the pace for six furlongs and tired. SUGAR TRADE placed three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. FIVEFIFTEEN three wide around both turns, folded.
