SEVEN DREAMS allowed to settle, ranged up three wide into the turn advancing on the front, swung three wide in upper stretch, got roused at the three-sixteenths, took command nearing the eighth pole, dug in inching away at the end to prevail. GEE LINZ hustled from the get go, crossed to the fence soon after the start, was placed to light urging along the inside on the pace under some pressure to the turn, got accompanied from there by a pair through the turn, was set down in earnest cutting the corner into the stretch, got displaced nearing the eighth pole, fought on to the wire clear of the rest. TATOO ME at the rear early on, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun four to five wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the drive. TINA'S NOTE prompted the pace from the two path, was between foes vying on the turn from the seven-sixteenths to the head of the stretch, got set down at that juncture and weakened. AGUALINDA threw her head at the start getting off half a beat slow, tracked the pace along the inside urged from three furlongs out, offered no serious response and weakened in the stretch. AWESOME ISLAND chased from the one and one urged along at the five-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home and tired.
