FLYING ZEALOUS became the primary pursuer soon after the start, was rated along while keeping a watchful eye on the runner up, undertaking the task from near the two path, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for run, steadily cut into the leader's margin, drifting out towards the middle of the strip, with the pilot intermittently flashing the whip right handed attempting to counteract this action, successfully wore down CROWN THE CHIEF near the finish line to prove best. CROWN THE CHIEF grabbed the early advantage after coming away from the gate with no apparent mishap, took up residence from just off the rail, cut the pace with the winner giving chase slightly to his outside and with the rider trying to hold something back for the stretch, got set down after completing the opening half, dug in well before yielding a few strides prior to the wire. TAKE DOWN TWO three wide at the three-eighths pole, finished willingly en route for the show. DEMON'S DEPUTY was gradually sent over into the two path down the backstretch, had no rally. REGAL STRIKE four wide into upper stretch, was no factor. FIGHT FOR V L T'S bobbed at the start, underwent a ground-saving journey, was under strong handling after going halfway on the bend, tired.
