MULTIPLE CHOICE argued the pace while three wide, dug in gamely through the stretch and prevailed after a hard drive. SPECTACULARSPENCER raced close up inside, angled out and came four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. DAYTON FLYER contested the pace while between rivals and weakened in the final furlong. COUNTRY BE GOLD broke awkwardly, was outrun early, rallied four wide and finished well. CLASSIC VERSE ducked in at the start, was outrun early and lacked a rally. PRINCE DE REVE (ARG) contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. WICKED WILL raced inside and tired.
