Footnotes

POACHAWAY steadied briefly in the early stages, moved out on the backstretch, rallied three wide to take the lead leaving the far turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. SLICK WHEELIE was reserved early, rallied three wide on the turn, chased the winner into midstretch and was gradually gaining at the finish. PRINCE DUBAI raced in midpack while four wide to the turn and finished evenly. CHERNOBYL'S HERO raced in traffic between rivals, lodged a mild four wide move on the turn and flattened out. CALL MICHAEL contested the pace between horses for five furlongs and tired. PAPA CHARLIE was outrun after breaking a bit slowly. PAVLOV'S DOG dueled briefly along the rail and gave way on the far turn.
