CHANGE OF COMMAND put to a strong hold leaving the elbow chute, took the inside route around the opening bend, found room and slipped outward midway down the backstretch, was taken outward some more, entered the far turn four wide, gained ground approaching the quarter pole and turned for home within range of the front runners, responded positively when given his cue, was the outermost of a trio reaching the eighth pole only heads apart from each other, ground his way to a narrow advantage past them both by deep stretch and edged away under good handling. KING TING (IRE) sat reserved from the outside for nearly three-quarters, was asked for run approaching the head of the lane and gave it, was sent over to the inside in upper stretch, wrestling away MOONHANGER's path and causing the rider of that mount to steady out of contention, bid boldly from the rail, with two others directly to his outside, in mid lane, dropped back slightly when no longer able to match stride for stride with the winner in the final seventy yards, but dug in well to garner the place. FOURSEVENTEEN raced three wide around both turns, took off with good energy when asked for a response heading into the stretch, fought with good intensity from between rivals from upper stretch until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole before weakening in the late stages into the show slot. PERVIS broke alertly and quickly grabbed the front, tucked over to the inside once sufficiently clear of LINDELL A. C., rated well, felt increased pressure from the previously mentioned rival leaving the backstretch, held back something until nearing the quarter pole, came under heavy pressure after settling into upper stretch, soon succumbed and weakened in the final furlong. LINDELL A. C. coaxed along stalking the pacesetter from the outside, moved up to increase the pressure upon reaching the second turn, kept up the pursuit until the furlong grounds before backing away. ACADIAN BLUES saved ground and had no kick. MOONHANGER contently tracked the front runners from the inside, was let out spinning into the lane from the rail, appeared to be moving with good momentum when cut off by the second place finisher in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, got steadied as a result and never did regain any real interest.
