### Footnotes

SAINT VIGEUR assumed the role of primary pursuer before reaching the end of the homestretch, patiently stalked the runner up from along the outside as that rival tossed out a pair of pedestrian initial fractions, departed the backstretch and was put to solid encouragement, kept within striking distance making his way around the far turn, had BAKER STREET came out slightly in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, forcing the rider to check off that foe's heels and yank the mount hard to the outside to avoid serious damage, forged on ahead and made up all the temporary loss of ground after the incident by the eighth pole, drew on even terms about a sixteenth later, out dueled the second place finisher the rest of the way to the wire to prove best. BAKER STREET quickly established control, set a pokey pace, at first under a firm hold by the pilot, then under some light coaxing proceeding down the backstretch, stronger hand urging at the start of the far turn until under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, came out slightly and was more in the two path than along the rail for the commencement of the stretch run, came out a bit again, this time at the three-sixteenths pole, resulting in top one being forced to check and lose some ground and momentum, had the winner directly alongside at the sixteenth pole, fought well but yielded, coming out slightly yet again during the final strides. NORUMBEGA tracked the front runners while saving ground, cut the corner under a drive, angled out in the stretch, proved no match. MISTER WOOLMAN the early trailer, moved when ready and looped by JACKIN MY STYLE with a four wide move nearing the end of the backstretch, cleared that opponent in short order and took over the three path, was asked for run by midpoint on the turn, picked up ground momentarily then backed away. JACKIN MY STYLE strung out three wide on the first turn, was rank under restraint for much of the opening half, tucked along the rail past the half mile pole and faded.
