FIZZY PINK (GB) off a beat slow at the start, settled two to three wide in mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, advanced stoutly into prominence at the head of the lane, rallied taking command just outside the furlong marker, offered up a good kick while slightly drifting out under a near sided stick to prevail repulsing an equally charging foe to the wire. TRULY MIZZED broke out at the start bumping HOPE RULES lightly then was squeezed back between foes as ANGEL CHOIR recovered her footing by coming outwards, saved ground towards the rear, came under urging just past the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home in behind the aforementioned rival, angled out a path nearing the furlong grounds, offered up good energy steadily gaining late but was held to the place on the wire. MEANS WELL forwardly placed three wide, took closer order into the far turn, came under urging midway on the turn advancing to seize the front at the quarter pole, spun three wide for home, tussled with the eventual winner getting headed near the eighth pole, ran on willingly for the show clear of the rest. HOPE RULES bumped at the start lightly by TRULY MIZZED who broke outwards, settled three wide towards the rear, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share while never threatening the top. ANGEL CHOIR lost her footing at the start and recovered coming outwards to lightly squeeze TRULY MIZZED between foes, raced just off the inside in range early, settled down the backside losing some position and took to the rail at the half mile pole, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch and weakened. CATERWAUL a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, tracked the pace in aim from just off the inside, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, swung three wide for home and weakened in the drive. JULIE NAPP bobbled slightly into the first turn, was well rated on the pace inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths as the pressure intensified, spun just off the inside for home displaced on the front and faltered in the stretch. GIANTESS rank early on under restraint along the inside behind foes, settled once taken to the four path five and a half furlongs out, ranged up into striking range at the half mile pole, faded through the far turn under urging midway and tired. PITCHED three to four wide towards the rear, shifted to the two path placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, made no impact.
