HAITIAN HEAT set the pace along the inside and dug in gamely through the stretch. DOC'S GIRL was outrun early, raced inside and offered a mild rally on the rail. LOWER RATE raced three wide and had no rally. ALMOST MAGIC pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. DARKEST MIRAGE had no response when roused. ELITE CAT was outrun.
