FULL OF INTENT broke on top, was allowed to ease back, conceding the front to CLEAN JEAN before reaching the end of the chute, sat patiently parked two to three wide proceeding her way to half mile pole, picked up interest upon reaching this station, ranged up towards the front runner, while not asked for more than her own natural speed, appeared to poke a head down in front as the field headed into the stretch, responded well when given her cue, scampered away from upper to midstretch, leaving the eighth pole in possession of her biggest advantage, saw that margin dwindle down steadily but held on well enough and for long enough under busy handling to prevail. EVAN'S ROCKET reserved from off the inside for nearly six furlongs, commenced her stretch drive three wide at the top of the lane, came home with good energy to garner place honors. NECESSARY LUXURY lagged behind in the early going, picked up the pace lightly hand urged leaving the half mile pole, was put to stronger encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the first two finishers. CLEAN JEAN took over soon after the start, once the winner was allowed to back off, sat well rated along the inside setting moderate opening splits, got confronted by the winner approaching the quarter pole, yielded without much resistance and tired. AURIC GIRL saved ground until the quarter pole, gave way.
