Footnotes

JOHN JOE settled into midpack from the inside, remained well reserved in the initial stages, had the rider cast several furtive glances back at the rider less horse to assess the situation before being guided into the three path coming to the end of the backstretch, overhauled AMBIT and was quickly placed back into the two path, continued to show good acceleration for the remainder of the run around the far turn, was nearly on even terms with the leader sputtering a bit wider into the lane, got straightened away and shot past WAR HITCH soon afterwards to take charge, drew off from the competition, finishing under a confident hand ride. BUNDESTAG (GB) was taken in hand along the rail as part of a bottleneck jam leaving the elbow chute, rode the rail until the three-eighths pole, got set down entering the stretch, proved no match for the winner, had place honors all but wrapped up when bothered slightly by the horse with no rider in the last seventy yards. WAR HITCH came outward at the break, made light contact with the nearest opponent before getting pulled off, quickly cleared the field to establish command and was sent over to the inside, showed the way from there, rating well and on a loosely-contested lead,

continued along on the same scenario for almost three-quarters, was asked for some run once the winner made his presence late on the far turn, relinquished during the initial portion of the stretch drive, eventually weakening into the show slot. SILVER SKATES three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied mildly to secure the last major check. AMBIT lightly bumped at the start, sat forwardly placed three wide until the three-eighths pole before backing away. GO TO THE NET angled inward sharply after the start, creating an early jam where the elbow chute merges with the homestretch, was unhurried from off the inside, bumped with CAROLINA CHANT before crossing over to the inside in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, causing the rider of the aforementioned rival to steady, was angled back to the outside for the stretch run, but soon flattened out. CAROLINA CHANT was steadied while put in tight quarters from outside pressure coming from GO TO THE NET nearing the beginning of the homestretch, took the inside route, was bumped by the same rival, then forced to steady off that one's heels nearing the end of the backstretch, recovered and managed to get going again, entered the lane under encouragement and with a touch of momentum, got steadied for a third time when carried inward by the rider less rival in upper stretch, capping off a rough trip. NORTHERN HERO steadied along the rail in the early stages and was outrun. ZOOT SUIT JOHNNY under a firm hold, worked out a tuck into the two path approaching the first turn, accompanied the leader from there for just over a half before retreating. ADIOS NARDO stumbled badly at the start unseating the rider. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
