MADISON AVE. JO JO assumed a forward position soon after the start, was rated along from the two path keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, closed the gap and turned for home on nearly even terms with NIGHT READER, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for a response, remained locked in a duel with the previously mentioned rival the rest of the way, wore down that foe to take over, then edged away. NIGHT READER broke on top, with the whole field coming away from the starting gate in good order, had the rider apply a rating grip on the reins, left the chute with control and settled along the inside route, rated kindly with the runner up making her presence all the while, had that one increase the pressure late on turn and was asked for some run in response prior to the quarter pole, entered the stretch clinging to the barest of leads, still clung to it after a tussle through the furlong grounds, relinquished reluctantly by deep stretch, remained well clear of the others for the place. WINMOR GOLD three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, proved no match. GALAXY GAL glided over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, rode it until the five-sixteenths pole, swung outward at that station until in the five path by the top of the lane, lacked the needed response en route to grabbing the last major check. YOU TAKE THE CAKE underwent a three wide pursuit until the furlong grounds before backing away. WILD SIREN between rivals for most of the way around the turn, displayed only brief foot. SEE SEE SEE saved ground throughout.
