Footnotes

GARNET STREET settled into midpack from off the inside, was patiently handled until halfway around the bend, was given her cue and angled outward, splitting rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, unveiled a bold burst of speed to take the advantage away FLASHY IN PINK prior to spinning into the stretch, drifted off gradually while extending the margin, being primarily under a strong ride, had the rider twirl and flash the stick from the right side for a stride or two in mid lane before resuming the strong hand ride, resulting in the mount once more drifting out slightly, remained well clear, having gotten geared down late. GUYANA PRINCESS well off the rail down the backstretch, was three wide by the half mile pole, continued to bide her time, was put to some encouragement and unleashed a run that carried her into a contending position, turned for home with no loss of momentum, lacked what was needed to reel in the top one while second best. CHANCE ENCOUNTER three wide departing the backstretch, was five wide entering the stretch, got outfinished. FLASHY IN PINK out a couple of steps at the break, was pulled off the nearest opponent with some force but not before making some contact with that rival, tipped into the two path and rushed up to confront STATELY CAT, at that time the leader, with the rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, came inward, placing the previously mentioned rival in tight before bumping her, settled along the rail soon afterwards, was rated along while cutting the pace, got overwhelmed with the winner's strong move heading for the quarter pole, stayed prominent for a little while longer before backing away. STATELY CAT gained a narrow advantage soon after the start while racing along the inside, had FLASHY IN PINK drew alongside shortly afterwards, shied inward as that foe came over in the direction of the rail, eventually got bumped with the rider losing his balance for a stride, fell back almost two lengths as a result, all this occurring soon after the initial split had been recorded, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey. HEY BABE had just settled into her stall when the gate was sprung open, reared up at the start, chased three wide on the turn, was put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, tired. AS RULING BL-35-2013 DATED 06/20/13 FROM NYS GAMING COMMISSION, GUYANA PRINCESS IS DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED DUE TO POSITIVE TEST.
