Footnotes

ALPHA J sat reserved from along the outside off a contested pace, was taken outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole until four wide at the head of the stretch, responded positively after being called upon to arrive at the furlong marker latched on to the runner up, grabbed the lead shortly afterwards and edged away. IBID vied for command from near the rail, shook free briefly turning for home, had the eventual winner close in to loom a dangerous threat with an eighth to go, yielded to that foe but continued on well enough to the wire to secure second. HUNDRED ACRE WOOD four wide for most of the way on the turn, rallied to take the show award. BOBITY BOO unhurried in the early going from the two path, was sent over to the inside midway on the turn, moments after PUMPKIN LANE had abandoned the premises, unleashed a rail run to scurry into contention, flattened out leaving the eighth pole. PUMPKIN LANE left the rail at the three-eighths pole, had no rally. BOLDCHILDSREVENGE out a bit at the start, was grabbed hold by the rider, disputed the pace with the second place finisher from the outside for a half and gave way. MARIE'S BABE three wide departing the backstretch, was through after completing a half.
