AWESOME raced with the pace while between rivals, dug in determinedly while between rivals in the stretch and prevailed after a long drive. FIVE TO FOUR set the pace and battled gamely along the inside through the stretch. CHEROKEE PROMISE raced close up outside, rallied three wide and weakened in the final furlong. CANDY HAZE hit the gate at the start, ducked in after the start, chased between rivals, rallied four wide into the stretch and weakened late. CHEROKEE RIDGE chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. UP THE VOLUME had no rally. GO NATALIE GO had no response when roused. JUNIPER SPRINGS was taken up at the start, was rushed up inside, chased the pace and tired. DREAMY LUCY tired.
